

KIBA POINT



Kiba Point is the fabulous new base for your private Selous safari with family or friends. This 8 bed camp is booked on a totally exclusive basis only, including all activities: game drives, walking safaris, birding, boating and fishing trips



LOCATION - this new 8 bed private camp is set on the banks of the Rufiji River, just downstream from Sand Rivers Selous. It is perfect for private groups of friends and/or families although, due to the openness of the camp, it is unsuitable for young children.



ACCOMODATION - 4 spacious, airy cottages (2 doubles/2 twins), made of stone and thatch, are raised up on platforms above the river line. The interiors are cool and elegant; huge beds with softly draped mosquito nets, planters chairs and sun-beds for chilling out. The bathrooms are spacious and open; with hot/cold running water, flush toilets, and an indoor and outdoor shower. There are plunge pools for every room and a large swimming pool at the main mess. The mess/ dining area spoils you with plump sofas, a library of books, your own bar, and lots of space to make your own. The food is fantastic, and the drinks are always ice-cold.



ACTIVITIES - all the activities at Kiba Point are exclusive to the camp. Private cars and guides are on hand to take you out for daily adventures: game drives, walking, boating, fishing, and fly-camping.



FLY-CAMPING - This option is highly recommended during your stay at Kiba Point, and is available at a supplement. There are spacious mosquito nets to sleep under, equipped with comfortable safari bedrolls. A bucket shower with hot water and a short drop toilet are set up behind camp. Kiba Point staff provide a full breakfast, light lunch and a three-course candlelit dinner.

HIGHLIGHTS - The sights and sounds of the river and the great variety of adventures to be had along its banks, and in the surrounding woodlands. Fabulous sightings of the river's residents (hippos and crocodiles), and great birding. Game drives, fly-camps, fishing, boat trips and walks through a variety of diverse areas - Steiglers Gorge, Kidai Island, Hot Springs, and Lake Tagalala.

CHILD POLICY - We are delighted to accept children of 12 and over at Kiba Point.

OPEN - Kiba Point is open until 20th March 2008, and then reopens on 1st June 2008.

HOW TO GET THERE - there are numerous daily flights to Kiba airstrip from Dar es Salaam, Zanzibar, Ruaha, Mafia, Pemba, and northern Tanzania.
