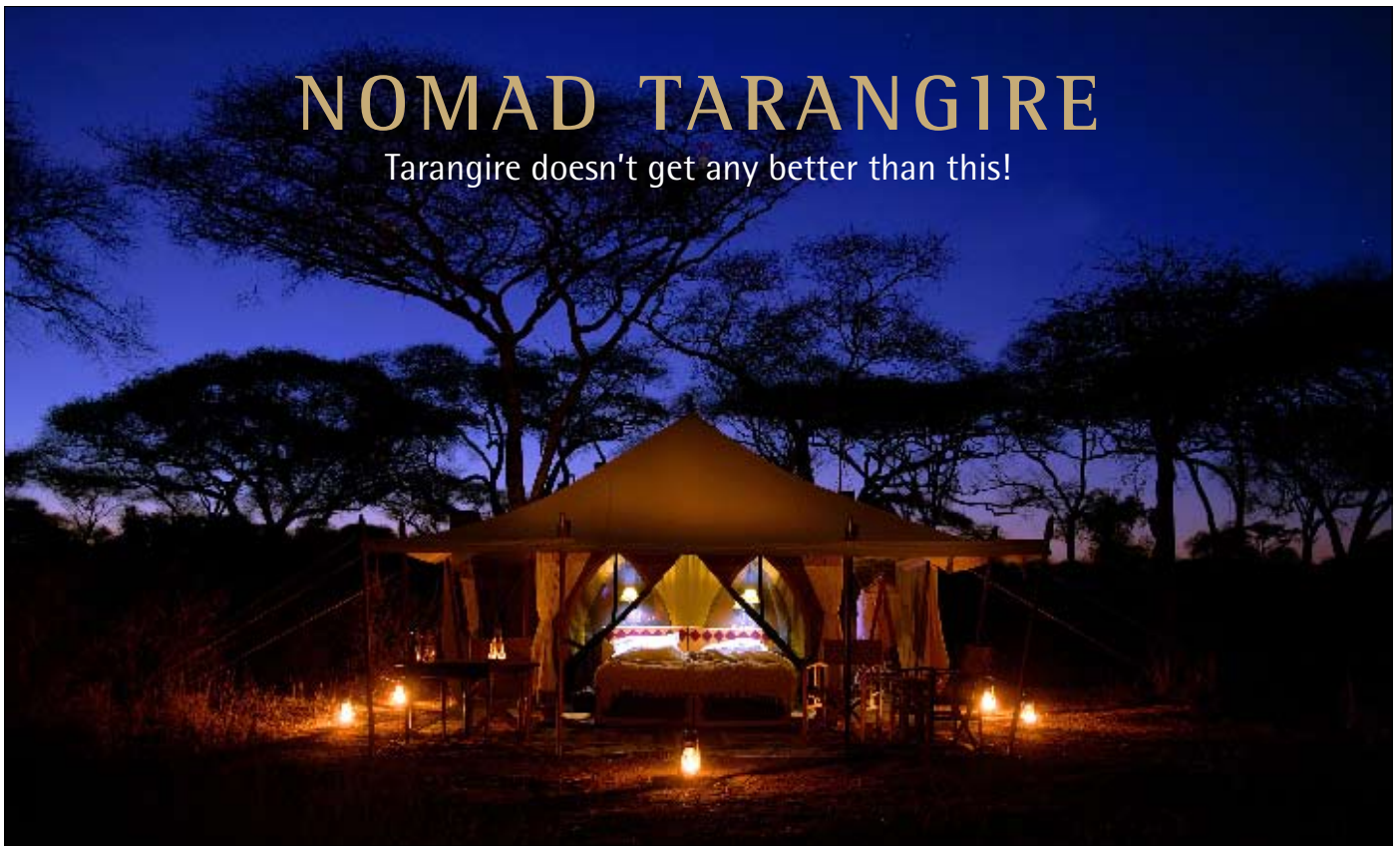


NOMAD TARANGIRE

Tarangire doesn't get any better than this!



Nomad Tarangire is Nomad's new 8 bed camp in Tarangire National Park. This small and stylish camp (think Bedouin meets the bush) offers the ultimate all round Tarangire experience; from game drives in the key game spots, with opportunities for exciting walking safaris and fly camping expeditions within the remote wilderness areas of the park.

The Nomad style gurus have been hard at work on the unique design of the new tents which offer comfort, space, and light and are designed to take full advantage of the passing breezes. The mess and dining tent is spacious, welcoming, and funky, and definitely somewhere to spend a relaxed afternoon, either inside in the library/lounge area or in the shade of a tree lying in a hammock soaking up the Tarangire vibe.

The landscape is famous for its Baobab trees which are scattered throughout the park. It's a strong, rolling wilderness that over the last hundred years has earned the respect of the bush-wise, first as a hunting ground, and more recently as a vital wildlife sanctuary in Tanzania's Great Rift Valley. Pristine bush, extensive wetlands, and permanent rivers attract masses of game into the national park's 2600 sq kms.



LOCATION - Nomad Tarangire moves between a number of selected campsites towards the remoter southern section of the park, from which both the game rich Tarangire river and the wilderness walking areas of the park are equally accessible. We can offer both 'facets' of this park without the need for long dusty drives.

ACCOMMODATION - Four uniquely designed "Bedouin style" safari tents: inner bed tent area with large comfortable beds, optional roll down canvas sides and shade netting. The outer 'living' area also netted with roll down sides, kilim rugs, screened dressing area and en-suite bathroom. Flush toilets and traditional bucket showers with hot and cold water available on demand.

Please note we cannot do triples in Nomad Tarangire.

ACTIVITIES - The park offers a host of excellent game driving opportunities in private 4WD vehicles with own private guide, fantastic walking safaris through the wilder areas of the park, phenomenal birding and game viewing with the park being well known for its large herds of elephants. Also migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland make it the greatest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem.

OPEN -The camp will be closed between 11th January 2008 and 31st May 2008, reopening on the 1st June 2008.

HOW TO GET THERE - Fly by daily scheduled flights from Arusha, or private charter to Kuro airstrip or drive in 4WD safari vehicles (camp is approx 2 hours drive from the main gate).

CHILD POLICY - We are delighted to welcome children of 8 and over at Nomad Tarangire. However, please note there is a restriction of 12 years and over on any walking or fly camping activities. All children stay at their parents' own risk.
