## WILDERNESS MOBILE SAFARIS in Katavi National Park



Nomad's Wilderness Mobile Camp (WMC) is the perfect way to enjoy a real bush experience. This is how safaris used to be, and yet so few are nowadays. A rare chance for roving adventure and true mobility. In Katavi, this camping safari allows the true adventurer to escape the core areas and explore the remoter regions of the park: camp by the flood plains of Paradise and Mpunga which play host to a large variety of game throughout the dry season; or for spectacular views, hike up to the Mlele escarpment and the Chorangwa Falls.

A mobile safari really is a safari in the traditional sense: as you move, so too does your camp, and each evening you will be welcomed home by the same familiar faces, no matter how much the setting has changed. The camp is serviced by a dedicated crew of seasoned professionals who can pack up the camp, whisk it to a new location and set it up again in time for your arrival in the evening. While it can move each day, we would strongly recommend two nights in any one site. The camp is only available on an exclusive basis with your own private guide and 4WD car, so you have complete freedom to plan totally flexible safari itineraries each day. We operate this camp with our top named guides, to ensure the greatest Katavi experience, and these guides are booked at an extra supplement.

Designed primarily a base for exploring remoter areas, with an emphasis on walking (where allowed) as well as game drives, the camp is light, simple, yet perfectly comfortable. There are 4 well equipped, walk-in tents with two cot beds and a bathroom set at the rear with a short drop toilet and bucket showers. There is a dining tent with a varied bar or you can dine al fresco under a canopy of glittering stars. The food is excellent, the fire place relaxing and the G and T's flow.

**LOCATION** - Katavi National Park. The campsites vary according to local game and weather conditions. Itineraries are based around 3 night, 4 night or 7 night safaris, and can be combine with a stay at Chada Katavi or Greystoke Mahale.

The Camp will move between Paradise, Chorangwa and Mpunga areas. Highlights include the Mlele Escarpment, Chorangwa Falls and the Mpunga flood plain.

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**ACCOMMODATION** - 4 well-equipped walk in tents with two cot beds in each, and toilet attached to the rear with a short drop toilet and bucket shower. Hot and cold water on demand.

**ACTIVITIES** - Private game drives in open 4WD vehicles, walking, birding, picnics and bush dinners.

**CHILD POLICY** - We are delighted to welcome children of 8 and over at WMC, however please note that only children of 12 and over can participate in any walking or fly camping activities. All children stay at their parents own risk

**HOW TO GET THERE** - Our shared charters fly into Ikuu airstrip every Monday and Thursday from Arusha or the Serengeti. It is also possible to book a private charter, though clients wanting to travel this way can also only travel on Mondays and Thursdays.

**OPEN** - This camp operates in Katavi from June to October. From November to June, it moves into the northern circuit.

**SEASON** - July to October: drying up after the rains. Daily temperatures increase during the season and the game starts to concentrate around the pools and water holes.
